

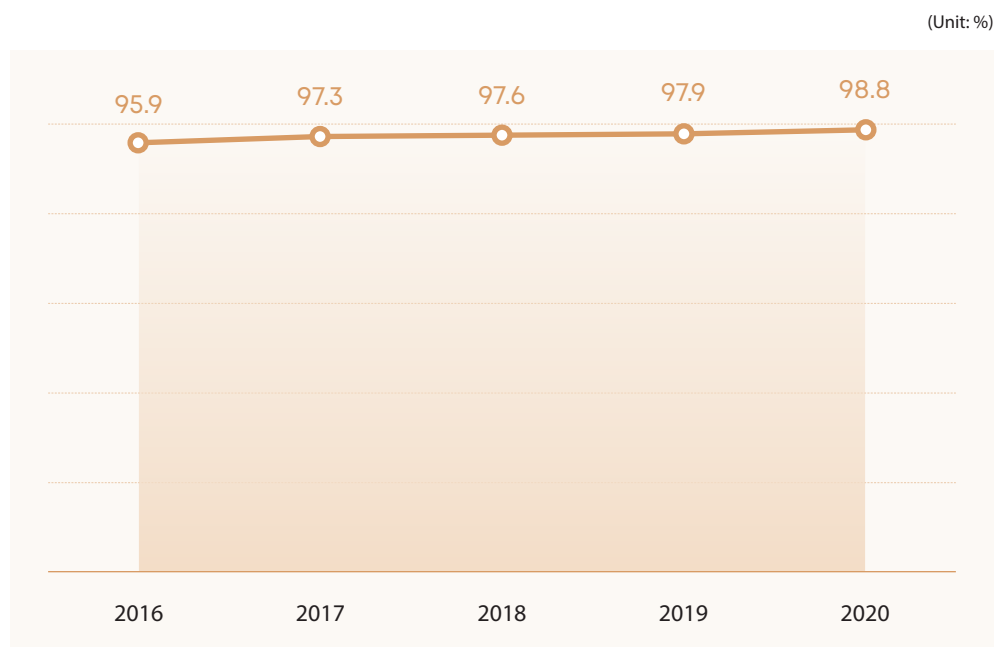
# Breastfeeding Index

## Proportion of breastfeeding

**Index definition** Proportion of breastfeeding from the admission of newborn to discharge

**Description** Helping mothers understand the importance of breastfeeding and allowing them to practice breastfeeding can contribute to improving the health of their newborns.



**Calculation** **Numerator** Newborns that had been breastfed  
**Denominator** Total admitted newborns

**Exclusion** **Denominator** Medical and non-medical reasons for being unable to breastfeed

- Medical: Mother with active tuberculosis, HIV infection, Infected with syphilis right before delivery, Herpes infection, Complications from delivery (acute hemorrhage and sepsis), Mother taking medicine harmful to the baby, Condition of the baby, Respiratory distress, cleft lip and palate, etc.
- Nonmedical: Single mother, personal reason, etc.
